When Manila Sunset opened its first store on Sunset Boulevard in Los Angeles, CA in 1985, its limited menu was originally intended for Filipinos in America who missed these foods for a long time. Soon, it gained the attention and approval, not only of Filipino-Americans but also other nationalities comprising the multi-racial communities of California.

Manila Sunset is one of the very few Filipino restaurants included in Paul Wallach's Guide to Restaurants of Los Angeles and Southern California and Linda Burum's Guide to Ethnic Food in Los Angeles

Manila Sunset also earned favorable reviews from the LA Times, Orange County Register, Pasadena Star News, The Hudson Magazine in New Jersey, and various Filipino newspapers and magazines. Manila Sunset was recently honored with Manila-U.S. Times Eagle Award of excellence as the "Restaurant of the Year".
